



Make a Child's Smile - Oral Health Screening Outcome

Your child participated in a dental screening performed by staff with the Mississippi State Department of Health. A dental screening identifies problems that are obvious to the naked eye and <u>does not include</u> a detailed examination or diagnosis. However, an oral health screening is helpful to call attention to obvious problems which you may not be aware of and to identify early risk factors for dental disease. An application of preventive fluoride varnish is also provided every six months to eligible children. Fluoride varnish is a concentrated form of fluoride that is painted on teeth to prevent tooth cavities.
