- 2. **STEMI Stroke Update** Harper Stone, MD
 - Data collection: Able to compare hospital outcomes and triumphs.
 - Data collection: Area hospitals can look at how they are doing in comparison to other hospitals.

3. MTAC Update - Carlton, EMSAC Chair

4. Update - MDTQA - Dr. Robert Galli:

- Request made for lactate measuring device. MDTQA found it to be acceptable device.
- Used to detect lactate level to assist in triage of patients at the emergency room.
- Drug Shortage: Compounding through pharmacy or other licensed agency is preferred. Adjusting medications such as epinephrine in the back of the ambulance is not acceptable.

5. Functionality Committee – Deschamp

- Recommendation: Emergency Medical Systems of Care Committee to replace EMS Advisory Council. EMS Advisory Council will now answer to new committee along with Stroke, STEMI, Trauma, etc.
