SUBJECT: Remdesivir Update: Direct Distribution Through
AmerisourceBergen

Dear Colleagues,

Beginning October 1, 2020, remdesivir will no longer be allocated by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Preparedness and Response (ASPR) and State Departments of Health.

Hospitals can submit orders for remdesivir directly to AmerisourceBergen for the treatment of hospitalized COVID-19 patients. AmerisourceBergen will remain the sole U.S. distributor of remdesivir through the end of this year and orders for remdesivir may be placed with AmerisourceBergen on an as needed basis.

Under FDA Emergency Use Authorization (EUA), Remdesivir is recommended for use in treatment of suspected or laboratory confirmed coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) in hospitalized adult and pediatric patients.

Ordering Remdesivir for your Hospital:

- Remdesivir will be available in AmerisourceBergen ordering platforms for inpatient settings only, using the following item numbers:
 - Veklury® (remdesivir) lyophilized powder: Item number 57889
 - Veklury® (remdesivir) liquid solution: Item number 57890
- Orders of remdesivir can be placed by emailing or calling AmerisourceBergen Customer Service (remdesivir@amerisourcebergen.com or 1-800-746-6273) and through AmerisourceBergen ordering platforms.

Definition of Alerting Vocabulary and Message Specification Settings

Originating Agency: A unique identifier for the agency originating the alert.

Alerting Program: The program sending the alert or engaging in alerts and communications using PHIN Communication and Alerting (PCA) as a vehicle for their delivery.

Message Identifier: A unique alert identifier that is generated upon alert activation (MSHAN-yyymmdd-hhmm-TTT (**ALT=Health Alert**, **ADV=Health Advisory**, **UPD=Health Update**, **MSG/INFO=Message/Info Service**)).

Program (HAN) Type: Categories of Health Alert Messages.

Health Alert: Conveys the highest level of importance; warrants immediate action or attention.

Health Advisory: Provides important information for a specific incident or situation; may not require immediate action.

Health Update: Provides updated information regarding an incident or situation; unlikely to require immediate action.

Health Info Service: Provides Message / Notification of general public health information; unlikely to require immediate action.

Status (Type):

Actual: Communication or alert refers to a live event

Exercise: Designated recipients must respond to the communication or alert

Test: Communication or alert is related to a technical, system test and should be disregarded



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Message Type:

- Alert: Indicates an original Alert
- Update: Indicates prior alert has been Updated and/or superseded
- Cancel: Indicates prior alert has been cancelled
- Error: Indicates prior alert has been retracted

Reference: For a communication or alert with a Message Type of “Update” or “Cancel”, this attribute contains the unique Message Identifier of the original communication or alert being updated or cancelled. “n/a” = Not Applicable.

Severity:

- Extreme: Extraordinary threat to life or property
- Severe: Significant threat to life or property
- Moderate: Possible threat to life or property
- Minor: Minimal threat to life or property
- Unknown: Unknown threat to life or property

Acknowledgement: Indicates whether an acknowledgement on the part of the recipient is required to confirm that the alert was received, and the timeframe in which a response is required (Yes or No).

Sensitive:

- Sensitive: Indicates the alert contains sensitive content
- Not Sensitive: Indicates non-sensitive content

Message Expiration: Undetermined.

Urgency: Undetermined. Responsive action should be taken immediately.

Delivery Time: Indicates the timeframe for delivery of the alert (15, 60, 1440, 4320 minutes (.25, 1, 24, 72 hours)).
