The **Training Specialist III** will provide support and training to public health staff and other partners and stakeholders. This position will assist with programmatic subrecipient monitoring activities, develop and review reports, and other duties as assigned. This work involves analysis of gaps and educational needs of the nine public health districts and developing recommendations for corrective action to meet state and federal requirements. This position will also be responsible for assisting in developing, scheduling, and screening of educational and other related programming.

Responsibilities: Provide support for projects within the Office of Workforce Development, including, but not limited to, providing support to public health districts, public health staff, MSDH partners and stakeholders, programmatic subrecipient monitoring activities, report development, and related follow-up activities.

Salary Range: \$51,693.41 - \$70,561.51 Annually - Directly related experience and advanced education will be considered for additional salary increases beyond the starting salary.

Location(s): Hinds County (Travel throughout the state will be required.)

Qualifications: Typically requires a Bachelor's Degree and 4-6 years of relevant experience.
