I	Call to Order	Dr. Donald called the meeting to order at 10:03
II	Roll Call	Quorum met.
III	<p>Old Business</p> <p>a. Review Minutes of Previous Meeting</p> <p>b. Follow up items from previous meeting</p>	<p>M: Ms. Kyle 2<sup>nd</sup>: Dr. Stacy Minutes approved.</p> <p>1. Develop specific CHARLIE criteria to bring back to MTAC committee: Dr. Donald stated CEC met this week and reviewed the possibility of a Charlie Criteria. Unforeseen issues with how it would affect the registry. The recommendation from CEC is to not endorse a Charlie activation criteria for the State. Individual hospitals can create a third tier of activation according to their own protocols.</p> <p>2. Dr. Donald discussed the information received pertaining to the centralized image repository system. Ms. Windham and Dr. Donald provided their estimated costs. There is another call on Monday, September 8 with the company for further discussion. <u>Discussion:</u> Will physicians be able to view remotely? Dr. Stacy states it's a hospital-based system and a member of the medical staff should have home access. Dr. Stacy commented it is very robust and would be beneficial to cut down transfers. Ms. Kyle asks: Are Radiologist included on this discussion, and if this going to be required for each facility. Dr. Donald will look at getting a radiologist added to the workgroup. The cost is paid for by the state so there will be no cost for the individual facilities. It will be required for all hospitals to participate. Dr. Stacy states it could be a cost-saving measure because it would be a better way to get scans to facilities in real time. Dr. Donald states this has benefits across all Systems of Care. Dr. Wilson asks if this would conflict with Pulsara. Ms. Windham shared Pulsara is communicative that incorporates some data, and this is a centralized platform for images. Dr. Rogers asks if there is language to prevent liability of looking at images and making decisions without seeing the patient. Dr. Stacy says it is on the agenda for EMSAC.</p>

Should start being able to use registry data. Currently looking at case reviews. Discussion about resources at a Level 3 hospital and what the expectation was for them to provide that level of care.</li> <li>Central District reviewed patient's being kept at lower level of care who had some neurosurgical injuries that were being kept at Level 3. These cases were reviewed for appropriateness of care, and all were deemed appropriate at the lower-level hospital.</li> <li>Discussion in the North District regarding implementing BIG criteria guidelines for Brain Injuries. Tupelo and Regional One are looking to implement BIG guidelines to keep patient's with minimal head injury close to home and avoid transfer.</li> </ul> <p>Ms. Kyle –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Summary: Tasked with revising current trauma rules and regulations to be more in-line with national standards, incorporate objective means to evaluate criteria. Some revisions made and approved by MSDH legal team. Other revisions are ready and sent to various approval committees. Revisions in progress for Level 3 Trauma Center items.</li> </ul> <p>Dr. Hodge –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Has met since last MTAC</li> <li>Data reviewed-tracking double transfers and length of time</li> </ul>
